PARTICIPATION IN ALL INDIA CBSE NATIONALS

The following are the rules of CBSE Sports Circular for the year-2026-2027 for participating in the nationals.

ATHLETICS:

The first & second position winning athlete in individual events and the first position winning relay team will be permitted to participate.

FOOT BALL, VOLLEY BALL, BASKET BALL , TABLE TENNIS & BADMINTON:

The first position winning team at Cluster meet will qualify to participate in the CBSE Nationals.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The rules and regulations have been framed as per the CBSE Inter School Sports and Games Competition.

ARTICLE: 1

ELIGIBILITY

1. This tournament is open only to the bonafide students (Boys & Girls) of the International Indian Schools in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi, India.
2. The bonafide students shall be eligible to participate in the Inter School tournament. Sending any non bonafide students shall lead to disqualification of the team.

ARTICLE: 2

Classification of Groups

1. The competition shall be conducted in the different age groups as per the CBSE operational manual of Inter School Rules & Regulations.

The Groups are classified as follows:

1. Below 19 years - Boys/Girls - Born on or after 01-01-2008
 2. Below 17 years - Boys/Girls - Born on or after 01-01-2010
 3. Below 14 years - Boys/Girls - Born on or after 01-01-2013
2. No school team shall be permitted to take part in any of the competition unless the eligibility of the player is not properly supplied to the host school along with the supporting papers as per the CBSE guideline & Rules.

ARTICLE: 5 **PARTICIPATION**

1. An Institution may participate in all the Games and Athletic Events. (Refer Article 3 & 4)
2. A junior participant can compete in the senior age group; however the participation in the original group will be forfeited.
3. Only bonafide students are eligible to participate in the Inter School Cluster Meets. Sending any non bonafide students shall lead to disqualification of the team.
4. A student cannot participate on behalf of more than one school in any tournament in the same academic year.

ARTICLE: 6 **GENERAL RULES**

1. A team Manager and coach for Boys and Girls shall accompany each contingent separately.
2. The participating schools shall inform the schedule of arrival and departure of their teams at least 10 days before the opening ceremony.
3. Every participant must possess the original or copy of his/her Iqama (resident Permit) and other traveling documents as required by the local rules of Saudi Arabia.
4. The participating schools shall send in advance two school flags, one each for March Past and one for hoisting. The size of the flag should be 1.5 mts x 1.00 mts.
5. The players should be dressed as per the rules of the game in which he/she is participating.
6. The food, boarding, lodging and traveling expenditure for the participants will be borne by the respective participating schools.
7. The host school will arrange for the accommodation for out station schools.
8. The transport arrangement will be provided for out station schools from airport to accommodation, accommodation to venue daily and accommodation to airport
9. The local schools will have to make their own transport arrangement.
10. The date of arrival shall be informed to the organizing school at least 15 days before the commencement of the tournament.

ARTICLE: 7
ENTRIES

MANDATORY

- a) The Participating schools must attach the receipt of proof of Payment of Annual Sports fee 2022-2023 along with Entry Performa.
- b) The organizing Schools at the Cluster level must not accept any entry without the above information.
- c) Submit a team photo with the school Principal along with their entry Performa.
- d) Student / Player studying in class IX & X should provide his/her CBSE Registration number.
- e) Student / player studying in class XI & XII (under 17 / 19 years) should provide his/her class X certificate with Photo issued by CBSE.

ENTRIES:

1. The entries for phase -I- i.e. Football, Volleyball, Basketball (Boys & Girls), Table Tennis & Badminton (Girls) must be sent on or before **04th May 2026**.
2. The entries for phase – II – i.e. Table Tennis, Badminton (Boys) & Athletics (Boys & Girls) must be sent on or before **18th May 2026**.
3. The entries for phase –III–i.e. Debate & Quiz must be sent on or before **10th October 2026**.
4. All entries should be send officially in time in the prescribed format duly signed and stamped by the Principal.(Refer Annexure II to VI)
5. The entries should be submitted (Boys and Girls) separately for each Game and Athletic Event.
6. Annexure No 1 - allotment of chest number for respective schools.
7. Annexure No 2 - entry form for Badminton.
8. Annexure No 3 - entry form for Table Tennis.
9. Annexure No 4 - entry form for Basketball & Volleyball.
10. Annexure No 5 – entry form for Football
11. Annexure No 6 - entry form for Athletics (Boys)
12. Annexure No 7 - entry form for Athletics (Girls)
13. Annexure No 8 - is consolidated list of participants.
14. Each Institution should mention the chest numbers (see Annexure No 1) of their participating Athletes, as per the allotment in the entry form and also Full Name, Class, date of birth and CBSE Registration number as per school record duly verified and signed by the Principal.
15. Each institution is allowed to give one individual entries for table tennis only apart from team championship.
16. A student can represent his/her school in only one age group for same game and athletic events.
17. An Athlete is allowed to take part in any two events (Excluding Relay Races)
18. An Athlete should be given only one chest number irrespective of the number of events he/she will be participating (Refer Annexure No 1)
19. Each school is allowed to give only one entry for each team game and athletic relay team.

ARTICLE: 8

TROPHIES, PRIZES AND CERTIFICATES

1. **The winners of previous year i.e. 2025-26 must bring the rolling trophies at the time of participation, if not participating they should arrange to send the rolling trophies to the hosting school.**
2. Individual prizes and certificates will be awarded for I, II & III places in games and athletics (Boys & Girls).
3. Participation certificates will be awarded to all participants of the event.
4. Rolling trophies will be awarded to winners of all the team games. (Boys and Girls)
5. Individual Championship in Athletics will be awarded to the best athlete in each group (Boys and Girls) securing highest points taking five places into consideration.
6. The player of the tournament in games i.e. one Boy and one Girl shall be recognized with a memento.

8. PRIZES FOR THE DEBATE & QUIZ:

- a. Rolling trophies will be awarded to winners for Debate & Quiz.
- b. The Prizes shall be awarded to all the team members of First, Second & Third Places.
- c. The I, II, III Prizes shall be awarded for best speaker in each group speaking FOR & AGAINST in Debate

MERIT SYSTEM (Awarding of points)

In the league system for games the points will be awarded as follows:

Win 3 points - Win by decision 2 points - Lost by decision 1 point – Lost 0 point

ARTICLE: 10

DRAWS AND SCHEDULE

1. The draw for each game for all groups will be completed at least one week in advance.
2. All draws shall be done by the organizing secretary in the presence of at least three officials of the organizing committee. A representative of the participating schools may be present at the time of draws.
3. Matches of different games / groups may be conducted simultaneously.
4. All the teams shall be divided in to two pools. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the knock-out stage matches.
5. In case of four or less entries, team games will be played on a league basis. Otherwise matches will be played on knock-out basis.
6. For arranging of matches on league basis the seeding of previous year shall be given.
7. The first two seeding for individual championships in table tennis shall be awarded as per the team championship results.
8. In case only two entries are received for team games, the final match will be conducted.
9. The Athletic individual event will be conducted subject to a minimum of three participants representing from 3 different schools each in Boys & Girls category.
10. Schedule of matches once fixed may not be altered, except for unavoidable reasons such as absence of officials, non-availability of grounds, inclement weather or any other reason deemed valid by the technical committee.
11. In case of more than four entries in team games 2 pools will be drawn and shall be played on league cum knock out basis for Table Tennis, Badminton, Football, Basketball, Volleyball and Badminton.

ARTICLE: 11

APPEAL / PROTEST

1. Any appeal or protest to be made should be done within one hour after the completion of match in writing and signed by the contingent manager / coach / P.E Teacher along with the Captain of the team with a complaint fee of SR.100.00 to the Organizing Secretary.
2. The fee may be refunded if the protest is upheld after proper enquiry is done by the technical committee.
3. The nature of protest or grievance should be clearly mentioned in the letter of appeal.
4. The appeal against the judgment of officials/umpire/referee will not be considered unless and until supported by the observation of any of the organizing committee members.
5. With regard to protest, the decision of the technical committee shall be intimated before the next round of match in the same game (tournament).
6. The decision of the technical committee will be final and binding upon all concerned.

ARTICLE: 12

BADMINTON (BOYS' & GIRLS')

1. CBSE Inter-School Badminton Tournament will be conducted according to the rules of Badminton Association of Indian (BAI).
2. Every school can send one team comprising of maximum four players, in Under 14, Under 17 & Under 19 yrs separately in Boys' & Girls' category.
3. All the participants must carry their valid age proof certificate and school/CBSE Board Identity-card.
4. All the matches must be played on indoor courts with proper lighting arrangements.
5. In Team Championship, the order of play shall be: Singles - Doubles - Singles.
6. All the teams shall be divided in to two pools. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the Knock-out stage matches.
7. All the matches that are played on "league basis" - shall be of best of one game of 31 points with change of side at 15 points. The player who reaches first at 31 points, wins the match.
8. All the matches that are played on "knock-out basis" - shall be of best of three games of 21 points each, & a match is won with the difference of 02 points. In case, of 20 - all; the game shall continue; however, the player who reaches first at 30 points wins the match.
9. At Zone Level all the matches will be played strictly on knock-out basis. In case the numbers of teams in a particular age category are less, the championship in that category may be organized on league cum knock out basis.
10. From each Cluster the first position winning team shall qualify for National level Tournament.
11. No change shall be permitted in the composition of team from Zonal Level to National Level.
12. The school Organizing Zone level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate in National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.
13. National Championship will be conducted on League cum knock-out basis for which all the teams will be divided into different pools.
14. At National level, one day of the Championship shall be dedicated exclusively to the Individual Championship.

INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP (BOYS' & GIRLS') ONLY AT NATIONAL LEVEL

1. In addition to the Team Championship, separate Individual Championship shall also be played at National level on knock out basis.
2. Each team reaching in the Nationals shall nominate one player who shall play singles title in each Age Category separately for boys & girls.
3. In each age group, as per BAI ranking list, the top ten ranking players shall be eligible to play directly at National level in "Individual Championship". However, if any player, ranking in top ten, has played at respective Cluster level Individual Championship, and has lost, shall no more be eligible to participate in Individual championship at National level.

MIXED DOUBLES CHAMPIONSHIPS - ONLY AT NATIONAL LEVEL

01. In addition to the Team Championship, a separate Mixed Doubles Championship shall also be played at National level on knock out basis.
02. Each team reaching in the Nationals shall nominate one player from its team (other than the one who has already been nominated to play Individual Championship) to play in Mixed Doubles Championship in each Age Category.
03. In all the Age Categories; the nominated Girls & Boys would be paired by lot.

FOOTBALL (BOYS')

1. All the matches shall be played according to the rules of All India Football Federation, unless, otherwise modified in these rules.
2. A Football team shall consist of maximum 18 players. No player shall be allowed to take part in the Tournament without proper kit.
3. All the teams shall be divided in to two pools. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the Knock-out stage matches.
4. Up to the semifinal stage matches, the duration of the match shall be 35-10-35 min. and the finals shall be of 45-10-45 min.
5. Maximum five players can be substituted in a game.
6. Procedure to determine the winner of a match shall be on the basis of penalty kicks where the competition rules require there to be a winning team after a match has been drawn.
7. The referee shall choose the goal at which the penalty kicks have to be taken.
8. If after both teams have taken five penalty kicks each, and both have scored the same number of goals, or have not scored any goal, penalty kick continues to be taken in the order of 6th, 7th and so on alternately from each side, until one team has scored a goal more than the other from the same number of kicks.
9. With exception of the foregoing case, only players who are on the field of play at the end of the match, which includes extra time, are allowed to take penalty kicks.
10. At Cluster level tournament too, if the number of participating teams is eight or less than eight, the tournament can be arranged with league system.
11. From each Cluster the first position winning teams shall qualify for National level Tournament.
12. The National level Tournament shall be played on league cum knock out basis. Knock out matches will commence only after the league phase of tournament is over.
13. In all the matches played on league basis points shall be awarded as '3' and '0' to winner and loser respectively. In case of a drawn match one point to each team shall be provided.
14. In case of a tie on the points system at the pool level, then the pool winner shall be decided on the basis of goal differences. If the goal scored by each team has no difference, the draw of lots may be provided to decide the tie which shall be held in the presence of Organizing School Principal, CBSE Observer, both the teams Captains & Chief Referee.
15. Semi-final losers' will play the hard line match to decide 3rd and 4th place in the tournament.
16. Unless unavoidable, no team shall be called upon to play more than two matches in a day. There shall be at least three hours gap between the end of the earlier match and the commencement of the next match.
17. First three teams (winner, runner-up and hard line match winner) will be provided with Merit Certificates. Other than the winners, all participants will be provided with Participation Certificate who actually participates in the tournament.
18. The school Organizing Cluster level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.

VOLLEYBALL
(BOYS')

1. The rules as adopted by the Volleyball Federation of India shall be followed, unless otherwise modified in these rules.
2. All the teams shall be divided in to two pools. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the Knock-out stage matches.
3. The matches at Cluster level shall be played as best of three sets, each set of 25 points. A set is won by the team which first scores 25 points with a minimum lead of two points. In the case of a 24-24 tie, play is continued until a two point lead is achieved (26-24; 27-25;)
4. The semi final and final, will be played as best of five sets. In case of a two - two sets tie, the deciding set (fifth set) will be played to 15 points until a two point lead is achieved (16-14; 17-15;)
5. Maximum two 'time outs' per set, of 30 seconds each will be allowed on the request of concerned coach/captain.
6. The colour and design of the playing kit of the members of team must be the same, except for 'libero' (defensive player) who must wear a uniform contrast in colour with that of the other members of the team.
7. At National level, matches shall be played on league cum knock out basis.
8. All the matches at National level will be played on the basis of best of five sets.
9. **At National level:** All the teams reporting may be divided into different pools in such a way that by and large no pool is of less than four teams. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the knock-out stage matches. The match to decide the third and fourth positions shall also be played.
10. In the matches played on league basis, in case of tie, the match will be decided as follows:

At first the following calculations will be taken -

Match won = 02 points. Match lost = 01 point. Match forfeited = 00 point.

Result will be tabled as under:

In case of a tie of total points at (D) between two or more teams, the following equation determines the ranking:

$$\frac{\text{Sets won (E)}}{\text{Sets lost (F)}}$$

The team of higher rate of sets will be ranked higher. If the tie still persists, the following equation will be applied:

$$\frac{\text{Total score points in favour (G)}}{\text{Total score points against (H)}}$$

Team of higher rate of scored points will be ranked higher.

If the tie remains undecided, precedence will be given to the team winning the match in which the concerned teams have played against each other.

11. Ordinarily, no team shall be called upon to play two matches a day. In exceptional circumstances, however if a team is asked to play two matches a day, there should be at least a gap of four hours between the two matches.
12. A team shall consist of a maximum of 12 players.
13. The first three position winning teams will be awarded with merit certificates. Remaining teams will be awarded with participation certificates.

The school Organizing Cluster level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing Nationals along with the original entry Performa.

ARTICLE: 13**TABLE TENNIS
(BOYS' & GIRLS')**

1. All the matches will be played according to the rules of the Table Tennis Federation of India (TTFI) as adopted by them from time to time, unless otherwise modified in these rules by the CBSE.
2. Every school can send one team comprising of maximum four players, in Under 14, Under 17 & Under 19 yrs separately in Boys' & Girls' category.
3. In Boys' Category, the team shall consist of maximum four & minimum two players.
4. In Girls' Category, the team shall consist of maximum four & minimum two players.
5. The order of play shall be as follows:

6. All the teams shall be divided in to two pools. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the Knock-out stage matches.
7. The matches shall be played best of three sets and from semi final stage matches will be played as best of five games.
8. The balls to be used in the tournament shall be ITTF approved.
9. The teams winning first three positions shall be awarded with the Merit Certificates. Not more than four Merit Certificates will be awarded to a team.
10. The remaining teams shall be distributed with the Participation Certificates.
11. From each Cluster, the First position winning team in each age group, separately in Boys' & Girls category, shall qualify to participate in the Nationals.
12. No change in composition of team from Cluster level to National level will be allowed.
13. The school Organizing Cluster level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams/Individual Players that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.
14. At National level team championship shall be organized on league cum knock out basis.

INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP - AT CLUSTER & NATIONAL LEVELS

- (a) In addition to the team championship, separate Individual Championship will be conducted at each Cluster level.
- (b) At Cluster & National levels, the Individual Championship shall be organized on knock out basis.
- (c) In Cluster level Individual Championship, only the schools that are participating as a 'team', shall be eligible to sponsor one player to play in Individual Championship in each category separately for boys & girls.
- (d) The scoring system will be the same.

IMPORTANT

1. Players can take time out for one minute, once in whole match.
2. Expedite system shall come into operation if a game is unfinished after 10 minutes play. If the expedite system is introduced, all subsequent games of the match shall be played under the expedite system.
3. Play shall be continuous throughout a match except that a player is entitled to:
 - (a) An interval of up to one minute between successive games of a match.
 - (b) Brief intervals for toweling after 6 points from the start of each game and at the change of ends in the last possible game of a match.

MIXED DOUBLES CHAMPIONSHIPS - ONLY AT NATIONAL LEVEL

01. In addition to the Team Championship, a separate Mixed Doubles Championship shall also be played at National level on knock out basis.
02. Each team reaching in the Nationals shall nominate one player from its team (other than the one who has already been nominated to play Individual Championship) to play in Mixed Doubles Championship in each Age Category.
03. In all the Age Categories; the nominated Girls & Boys would be paired by lot.

ARTICLE: 14

BASKETBALL (BOYS' & GIRLS')

1. The tournament will be conducted according to the Basketball Federation of India rules.
2. The number of players representing a school shall not more than twelve.
3. All the teams shall be divided in to two pools. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the Knock-out stage matches.
4. The match to decide the third and fourth positions shall also be played.
5. In any match, played on knock out basis including the final, if there is a tie, extension of five minutes shall continue to be given till the game is decided.
6. In case of a tie in matches played on league basis, the following procedure shall decide the winner, runner-up etc.
 - i) The team which has beaten the other team in the league matches shall be the winner.
 - ii) The tie between more than two teams will be decided on the basis of points scored and points against. The team securing the greatest quotient will be the winner. The points scored for and against shall be counted only in the matches played between the teams in tie.
 - iii) If the tie still persists, the formula will be points scored - points against. The team with highest difference is declared the winner. Again the scoring will be counted in the matches played between the teams in tie.
7. The number "6" size Ball will be used for Girls' matches.
8. A team shall be prepared to play more than two matches in a day.
9. All participating teams shall carry with them two sets of playing kit (uniform), one set of light color and the other set of dark color.
10. The team that has been named first in the fixture, will sit on the left side of the Official's Table, and shall score towards the right side of the court.
11. The school Organizing Cluster level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.
12. Protest if any, must be submitted in writing along with the fee within 20 min after the declaration of the result.
13. In case a team intends to protest against the opposite team; the Captain of team that intends to protest, must sign the score sheet.
14. In case a team forfeits & walks out of the court without completing the match, it shall lose the right to submit any protest and shall be debarred from rest of the tournament.

ARTICLE: 15

ATHLETICS (BOYS & GIRLS)

1. The meet shall be conducted according to the rules of Amateur Athletic Federation of India and also per CBSE Inter School Sports and Games competition Guidelines and rules 2026-27.
2. Every school will be allowed to enter one athlete in each event and one team for relay.
3. An athlete is allowed to participate in maximum of Two events excluding relays.
4. On the spot entry / changes will not be permitted.
5. The participating school shall bring their own chest numbers and must wear as allotted in the entry form before the start of the each event.
6. The athletes will be allowed to use their own starting blocks.
7. If any athlete participates in more than the prescribed number of events or with out the prior entry replaces for another athlete, he/she shall be disqualified immediately and all prizes won and points scored by him/her shall be cancelled.
8. Individual championship will be awarded to the best athlete in each group securing highest points taking five places into consideration.
9. In the field events three chances will be given to all the participants subsequently, three more chances will be given to the best six athletes.
